#### Why are there brown spots in my bermudagrass?

Brown spots in bermudagrass can be caused by a variety of factors, including diseases such as Helminthosporium or Bipolaris, which is a common disease in bermudagrass. This disease attacks roots, crowns, stems, and leaves, causing long reddish-brown to purplish-black spots that eventually kill the leaves, resulting in frosted or tan circular areas in the field. Low potassium levels and spittlebug injury can increase the susceptibility of bermudagrass to this disease [<sup>30</sup>]. Additionally, Rhizoctonia, a disease caused by soil fungus, can infect stems and leaves in hot, wet weather, leading to brown circular patches [<sup>30</sup>]. To manage these diseases, it is recommended to keep potassium levels up, burn fields before green-up, control spittlebugs, and harvest grass on a regular schedule [<sup>30</sup>].

If you are in Oklahoma, it's important to note that Spring Dead Spot (SDS) is a common disease of bermudagrass, but rarely of buffalograss or zoysiagrass in the state. Symptoms include dead and bleached white areas of turf, which may expand in size or disappear over time, and affected plant parts, such as rhizomes, crowns, roots, or stolons are dark black and rotted when removed from the soil [<sup>20</sup>].

If you are experiencing brown sports in your bermudagrass, it would be beneficial to have a soil test to determine if there are any nutrient deficiencies, particularly in potassium, which can be a contributing factor to these issues [<sup>10</sup>].





more effective control of woody plant encroachment [<sup>1]</sup>]. This can be particularly beneficial in areas with high woody plant encroachment, as goats can increase rangeland productivity and potentially increase the stocking rate of cattle [<sup>1]</sup>].

In general, two goats can be added per head of cattle without decreasing cattle stocking rate, so in an operation with 20 cows, 40 goats can be added while maintaining the same number of cattle [<sup>1</sup>].
